(Brief narrative of accident. Include statement of reeponmbility and recommendations for action to prevent repetion -
Aircraft landed at iarcanise airfield, Italy after becoming losteon return from a combat mission. The plane was serviced with fuel and the Pilot filed a clearance at Warcanise jose Operations. The weather was unfavorable on route and at the hone base, and the landing at Castelluccia would have to be made after dark. In spite of these conditions the aircraft was cleared.

The crash occurred at Rochetta, Italy (4105N 1530z). Apparently the Filet was trying to lot-down below the weather too soon and ran into dill.

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It is the belief of the Aircraft Accident officer that Aircraft 42-51661 should not hero been cleared te take-eff Prem Narcanise dir File so late in the artorneen for a flight over mountains whore some peaks wore cloud covered and rain was a hazard to flying safety. The Pilot was in error when he requested a clearance and teok-off after studying weather conditions and rate forecast but it is believed that faulty technique was used in clearing an operational aircraft, that had just returned frena a combat mission, when weather conditions had grounded aircraft of the Air Transport Command.

It is understood that the six passengers requested permission te fly in this aircraft after learning that aTC was grounded. Poor judgment was exorcised in clearing those personnel for a flight in an operational aircraft.
