

STATEMENT

On 29 December 1944, I was flying in B-24 aircraft #460, Piloted by 1st Lt. Richard C. Burkett. The ship was flying in the # 1 preition of the low flight, as the group formation began its bomb run over Udine, Italy. As we approached the target I saw the #2 ship in our flight, piloted by Lt. Martin E. Uhl, receive a direct hit by anti-aircraft fire between the waist window and the tail. It tore off the covering of the fuselage and I could see the ribs exposed between the window and the tail. The ship immediately dove underneath our plane and I did not see it again. Approximate time 1305.


On 29 December 1944, I was flying as photographer in B-24 aircraft #52, piloted by 2nd Lt. Harold S. Patterson. The ship was flying in the #7 position of the 2nd attack unit, as the group formation began its bomb run over Udine, Italy. As we approached the target I saw the #2 ship in the low flight piloted by Lt. Martin E. Uhl, receive a direct hit by anti-aircraft fire Just back of the waist windows. The ship passed underneath the rest of the formation and aimost immediately the tail assembly broke away and fell free. The ship fell in a flut spin and as it approached the ground it went into a steep dive and plunged to earth. I saw one parachute open, and I do not believe there were any others or I would have seen them.



1. You will be interested to know that there have been formed here in Washington and in the theaters overseas, Missing Aircrew Research and Investigation Offices to collect all information from our own and enemy sources, correlate this information and furnish it to search teams in the theaters who will go to the scene of the casualty incident and investigate, These teams will question those in the srea who have knowledge of the incident and trace all leads down until they have the story. The German records we have translated are excellent. We have just received the Japanese records. By combining all this data with the story available in your memory, we can tell next of kin the things that mean so much to them.

2. You may or may not have been questioned in this manner before concerning the mission on which you were shot down and the events that followed. Regardless of previous questionnaires, it is important that we have the information requested here to complete our records concerning combat crewmen remaining in a casualty status.

3. If you have been sworn to secrecy as a result of your escape, evasion or internment, you may consider yourself released from all restrictions as to disclosure or publication of experiences except:

- a. Secret intelligence activities and methods developed for use, or actually used, in prison camps.
- b. Details of techniques employed by military intelligence organizations operating behind enemy lines to assist evasion and escape.
- c. Negotiations conducted on high government or military level to secure release from internment in a neutral country. (See AAF Reg 46-8 dated 30 October 1945)
