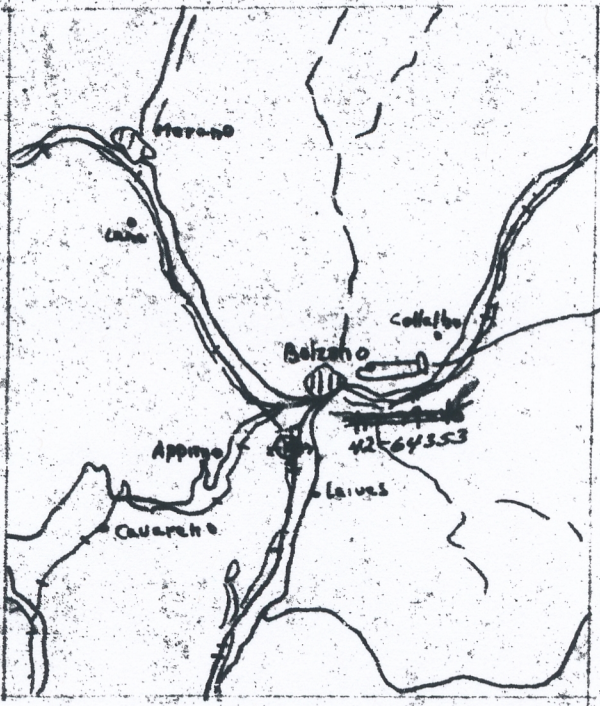

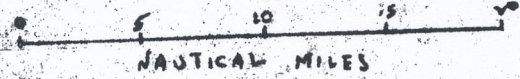


LOCATION OF PLANE

S T A T E M E N T

I, WILLIAM C. STENNING, O-672475, AC, flying in formation on 29 March 1944 with B-24J airplane No. 42-64353, piloted by 2nd Lt. JOSEPH M. YOUNGER, O-541835, AC, saw shell fragments hit subject aircraft, causing No. 2 engine to feather over the target. Airplane No. 42-64353 was not seen from that time on.

Subject : Death of a British Pilot

An American pilot was shot down with a bomber in the vicinity of Trient, wood area at  
Stenige, about 15 km north-east of Trient, on March 29, 1944. Body nearly burnt.  
The name no longer recognizable. The remaining parts of body were buried at the  
sanctuary of Baselga di Pine about 3 km south of place of crash.
