## STETEMENT

## On 26 December 1944 , Second Lieutenant William $F$.

 Jackson, 0-705024, was pilot of a B-24 type airoraft, AAF Serial Number 42-78606, no nick-name, on a bombing mission over a synthetic oil rerinery looated at oswiecim, Poland. On the return journey at approximately 18,000 feet, between Nitra, Czechosiovakia and Gyor, Hungary, the formation in which Lieutenant Jackson was flying encountered intense, accurate and heavy anti-aireraft fire which severely damaced Lieutenant Jeokson's aircraft. Ee withdrew from the forma tion and began to straggle behina. He state ${ }_{2}$ over the radio that his rudder controls were damaged and that his oxygen was low, ond that he was going to lose altitude and try to make Vis. He followed the formation into Yugosis via and was last seen at approximately 1445 hours at $45^{\circ} 41^{\prime} \mathrm{N}-16^{\circ} 44^{\prime} \mathrm{S}$. He appeared to have control of his aircraft and $k i l$ engines appeared operative. No perachutes were seen tc leave the airplane. The weather was clear at the time.Nothing further has been heard from Lieutenant Jackson or his orew and the undersigned has no opinion as to their re.te.
