




Y. : CO, Pensouth, Naples, Italy To 1. Aircraft B-24H Ser 42-95239 was last sighted off the coast of Rimini, 4 November 1944. Casualty information indicates that suf-ficient evidence was received on 16 June 1945 to declare all men KIA on 4 November 1944. Reel, as requested in paragraphs 2 and 3 of letter, Subject: Investigation of Air Casualty, dated 17 December 1945. "Basis: Scattered and burned out wreckage of plane found North of Chieti, Italy. Eleven bodies were found within 400 yards radius of plane wreckage. The oddes of Lt. Joung, W.R.Sgr. Wehn, C.A., Shield, H. E., Price, T. J., and Bousquet, G.J., were definitely identified by various positive means". C.A., 2.
