HOUSE RULES

1. CLUB opens 9:00 A.M., closes midnight. Closes Saturday night at 1:30 A.M.
2. BAR opens at 4:30 P.M. for mixed drinks from your own bottle.
3. DINING ROOM HOURS. Luncheon 11:30 to 1:30 (Sunday 11:30 to 2:00).
Dinner 6:00 to 8:30.
4. CLASS UNIFORM required AFTER RETIREMENT. FIELD JACKETS, FLIGHT JACKETS,
and sweaters are NOT PERMITTED at any time.
5. MEMBERS WILL NOT FLEETWALK, drink, date or eat WITH CLUB EMPLOYEES
(civilian or enlisted) within the premises of the CLUB.
6. The signing of chits or credits in any department of the CLUB is prohibited.
7. Tipping of employes is prohibited in the dining room, bar, and snack bar.
8. All members' checks over \$25.00 and transient Officers' over \$10.00
must be approved by the Club Officer.
9. DUES ARE PAID MONTHLY IN ADVANCE. Delinquent members will be reported to
the Commanding Officer.
10. No sleeping on the couches. Feet will be kept off the furniture.
11. Members will use the telephone at the bar or in the lobby for Post calls,
and the pay stations in the lobby for off the Post calls.
12. Children under eighteen (18) are not permitted in the Bar room.
13. The Club is for Officers, Officers' wives, and the friends of Officers,
and such Honorary Members as the Board of Governors may designate. Members
of Officers' families and house guests will be allowed the privileges of the
Club. All other civilian guests must be accompanied by an Officer.
14. The Club Officer, Officer of the Day, Courtesy Officer of the Day, or any
member of the Board of Governors shall have full power of enforcing the
house rules. Members have a right to appeal such decisions before a meeting
of the Board of Governors. All appeals or complaints shall be in writing to
the Board of Governors or directly through the Club Officer.
15. Suspension will result if the house rules are violated. Such suspension will
be directed by the Board of Governors.
